Guest Information

Check-In Time:

The check-in time is 5:00 pm on day of arrival.

Check-Out Time:

The check-out time is 2:00 pm on day of departure. If an extension is necessary, please check with management.

Complimentary Items:

One blaze-orange, Outdoor Obsessions hat is provided for each hunter purchasing a hunting package. Also, enjoy our open bar each night of hunters stay.

Meals:

Your hunt package includes three generous meals per day. Breakfast is served before your hunt, lunch may be served in the field or at the lodge depending upon conditions, and dinner is served after your hunt. Our kitchen and dining area is located at the center of our 3400 sq ft complex.

Smoking Policy:

We have a non-smoking facility but do have 3 outside spaces where smoking is permitted. Please do not disrespect our lodge by smoking in any interior room..

Deposit:

A deposit should be made 60 days prior to hunt. We require a non-refundable \$150 deposit per hunter at the time of reservation. Once deposit is made, hunting dates will be confirmed.

Payment:

We accept cash, personal/corporate checks, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover. Balance of hunt payment is due upon arrival.

Housekeeping:

The quality of your stay is ensured by our fine housekeeping staff. We want our guest to feel as if they are in their own home. Extra blankets and towels are available.

In-Room:

Each room is equipped with 1-3 beds, nightstand with light, alarm clock, large closet, pillow and linens.

Pets:

We allow animals to stay within the rooms at night. Some restrictions do apply, as follows:

- Animal must be in enclosed kennel;
- Animal must be use to household atmosphere, no barking or whining;
- Animal must have all needed vaccinations and must never show aggression.

Please ask management for further details.

Hunting Regulations:

We strictly adhere to all state and federal regulations. It is your responsibility to do so as well. Failure to comply is grounds for immediate termination of both your hunt and your stay with us.

Licenses:

We recommend that all hunters purchase a hunting license before arriving. The best option is to purchase your license on the internet or at licensed KS dealer (i.e. Wal-Mart, Sporting Store). To purchase on-line, connect to www.kdwp.state.ks.us and follow the steps for hunting license. Completion of a hunter safety course is required for all hunters if born after July 1, 1957 for all of our wild game hunts.

Note: If only going to hunt our preserve, you only need to purchase a Controlled Shoot license. If planning to hunt waterfowl, hunter will also need to purchase a KS HIP Stamp, KS State Stamp, and Federal Stamp.

License Fees: (Resident \$20.15) (Nonresident \$72.15) (Nonresident under 16 \$37.15)
(Controlled Shoot \$17.15) (KS HIP Stamp \$2.15) (State Waterfowl Stamp \$6.65)
(Federal Stamp \$15.00)

Hunting Equipment:

You will need to bring the straightest shooting shotgun you own. We recommend either a 20 or 12 gauge loaded with #4's, 5's, or 6's. Non-toxic shot is required for waterfowl. Be sure that your shotgun is in good, working condition. Is there anything more frustrating than going on a hunting trip with a jamming gun? Besides, you don't want your hunting partner to get all the shooting.

Clothing:

The Kansas weather is notorious for changing very quickly one way or another. Beware of the time of year your hunt is booked and have the proper clothing. We recommend that each hunter have the proper hat, shooting glasses, hearing protection, hunting vest, shooting gloves, hunting pants, and boots. You are investing time and money into your trip; make sure you do some good research to enable you to have the best trip possible.

Game Processing:

Cleaning your game at the end of the day is our job. Please have a cooler for transporting your game home after your stay.

Littering:

At Outdoor Obsessions, we have a great respect for the land. We do not litter and expect the same from our guests. Please do not litter, but do feel free to pick up any litter you may see.

Gratuities:
